



Look, if the prices in the city center seem a bit out-of-the-expected-range to you - it is no delusion, just an effect of the extreme quantum to fourists. Advice? Get on a bike or use your feet, make a trip out of the town and be sure you find beer under 35 CZK. We do it too! We storm out even for a romantic date. Dress up! Even though it's warm and you're on the river, as long as you stand on the shore, you're in the city. And there is nothing more horrible than some potbellied men walking the beautiful picturesque Krumlov dressed only in wet shorts or even worse - in speedos!

Drink beer. Easy enough. Krumlov has its own brewery called Eggenberg (which is continuously in trouble), but we are not picky and we absolutely drink other beer.

Make your peace with the crowds. We come to the city center for work, we do not live there - so it is the same as to go to work in some big office building... Only the office does not close outside the season.

Imagine living in the museum or reservation. Loads of tourists always shooting with their cameras. Someone tells you what to build and what to tear down. But still, we do not complain about UNESCO too much. It it brings no straight money, but does bring work and (sometimes kinda too much) life to the city.
